

At HPA Training, the safety and wellbeing of our students, sub-contractors and staff is our first priority so we would like to update you on the precautions we are implementing regarding the Coronavirus (COVID-19) situation.

HPA Training is closely monitoring advice received from the Work Health Organisation (WHO) as well as the Australian Department of Health. As a result we have adopted the following control measures in order to minimise the risk of infection:

- All students must fill out the declaration form at course commencement to declare they are not unwell, have followed the regulations and recommendations regarding the self-isolation provided by the Department of Health and they haven't knowingly been in contact with anyone that has had a confirmed diagnosis of COVID-19.
- All students and staff are advised not to come to training / work if they are feeling unwell
- Students are encouraged to spray and wipe down parts of equipment that can be disinfected before and after they have used equipment (with the disenfectant/or bleach spray and paper towels provided)
- Soap/hand sanitisers are available at our office and training facility and trainers will advise all students through the induction procedure regarding handwashing, hand sanitising, coughing, sneezing and personal hygiene
- Small class sizes with the layout of desks 1.5 metres apart
- Trainers will remind all students to wash and sanitise their hands regularly throughout the day
- Practice social distancing
- Students are encouraged to bring their own PPE and pens
- Tables and chairs will be wiped with disenfectant at the end of each day/class
- Trainers will try and leave classroom doors open to limit amount of contact with door handles
